



## WATER CONSERVATION WORKSHEET

### Level 3 Reading

#### Teachers Guide

Directions: Students write the sentences that they think are correct, then the teacher reveals the correct answers and leads discussion about saving water.

- **Example: FACT**—hand washing can use 5 times as much water as a dishwasher.
1. Letting the water run takes more water.  
**FACT**—you can save up to 20 gallons a day by turning off the tap while you brush your teeth.
  2. Overwatering the lawn uses more.  
**FACT**—the average American home will use about 100 gallons of water per day watering the lawn.
  3. Drinking bottled water takes a lot of water.  
**FACT**—it takes about 1.5 gallons of water to make a single plastic bottle of water.
  4. A hamburger takes more water.  
**FACT**—a quarter pound hamburger takes about 375 gallons of water to make.

**Discussion:** Class can discuss, write sentences, share stories, etc.
